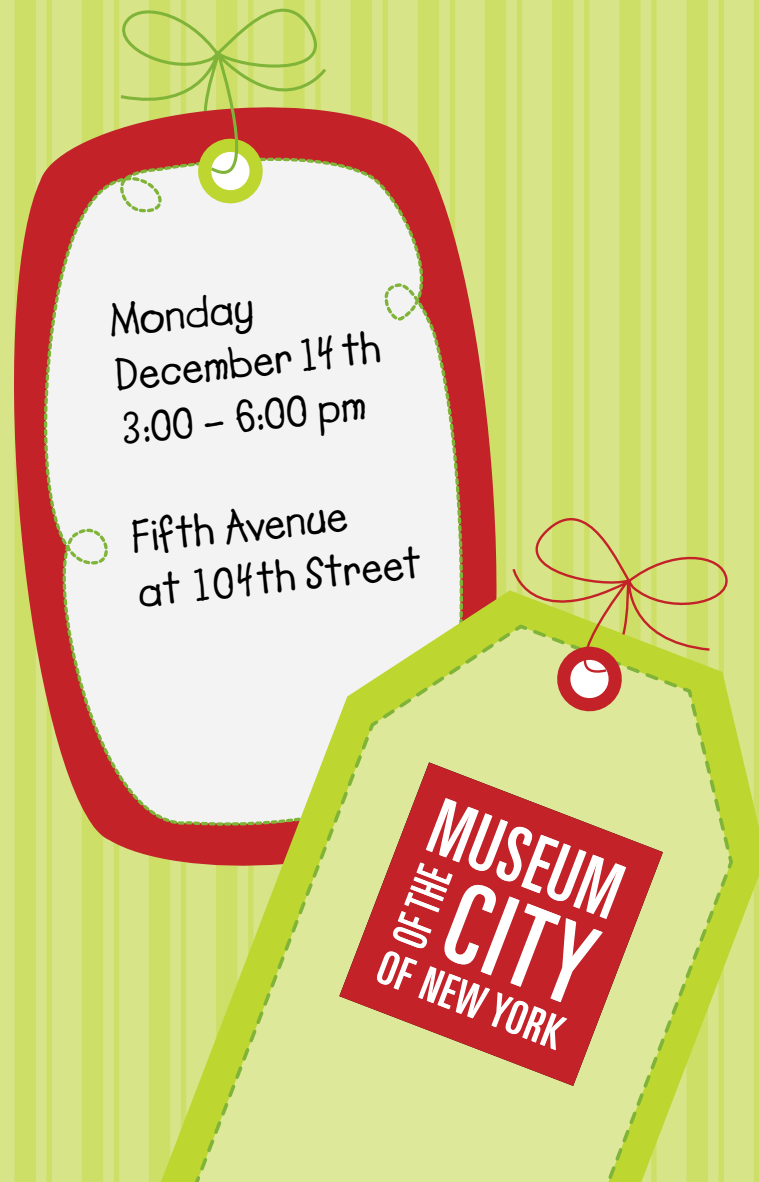

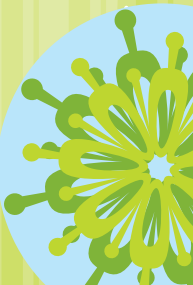

The Frederick A.O. Schwarz Children's Center at the Museum of the City of New York offers innovative education programs that help children learn about New York City's history and their place in it. The Center provides a rich mix of lessons and hands-on activities, a semester-long program that explores East Harlem's evolving neighborhood, and a city-wide history competition that encourages independent student research. Our Saturday Academy provides American history enrichment and free SAT preparation to East Harlem teens, and our Family Programs provide homeless children with workshops and live performances that celebrate the city's cultural diversity. Nearly 40,000 students and teachers visit the Schwarz Center every year.

Proceeds from the Children's Holiday Party provide essential support for the Museum and the educational programs at the Frederick A.O. Schwarz Children's Center.

The Museum of the City of New York celebrates and interprets the city, educating the public about its distinctive character, especially its heritage of diversity, opportunity, and perpetual transformation. Founded in 1923 as a private, non-profit corporation, the Museum connects the past, present, and future of New York City. It serves the people of New York and visitors from around the world through exhibitions, school and public programs, publications, and collections.
