### Application Components

- Proposed session title
- Session format (select from presentation, panel, workshop, or other)
- Who is the target audience for your session? (may include educators, students, young adults, administrators, museum professionals)
- Session overview: describe your session's goals, activities, and overarching themes (750 words or less)
  - o What are your session goals?
  - o What are your central questions and how will you frame them?
  - o What activities, media, documents, etc. will you use to engage your audience?
  - o What do you hope to impart to your audience?
- How does your session support or address this year's conference theme?
- Session outline: please write an outline or agenda with timing for how the 50-minute session will be structured, including time for feedback, discussion, and/or Q&A with session participants
- Why is your session important to you? Please describe the expertise, classroom experience, or any other background information of any of the presenters that relates to your session proposal (750 words or less)
- Learning outcomes for participants (3 required) and presenters (1 required)
- Session description for publication (100 words or less)
- Audio-visual needs and room set-up needs
- Are you willing to be included on a panel with another presenter(s)?
- Names of co-presenters (up to 6 total presenters)
- Are any of the co-presenters youth?
