Enjoy art, interactives, and artifacts depicting the streets and subways of New York in **Tempo of the City**; the stories of home and community in **At Home in New York**; and the images of the magnetic places where New Yorkers and visitors alike gather in **Destination NYC**.

**You Are Here** is an immersive film, which draws on the rich archive of movies set in the city to create a dazzling montage of cinematic moments that comment on each other across time and space.

**Scenes from the City** features a treasure trove of behind-the-scenes stills of feature films being made in New York, which have created a dynamic and ever-evolving portrait of the city.
