



## Open Call for Submission to New York Now

The Museum of the City of New York invites amateur and professional photographers to submit images or videos for consideration for inclusion in the next iteration of an ongoing series of triennial photography exhibitions, *New York Now: After Dark*. Submissions open on **Wednesday, June 11, 2025**.

### Exhibition Description:

For many, when the sun goes down, the possibilities for leisure, entertainment, and social gatherings unfold as the work day ends. In the dark there is possibility, mystery, and freedom from the constraints of broad daylight. Inhibitions wane and ambitions grow. At the same time, the night brings the third shift. For some it is a time to work, a time of commerce. Nightly, these worlds collide and provide the electric energy for which New York City is known. This exhibition aims to look at the New York night and how artists have responded to it.

The curators are looking for work made in a series that explore a subject of theme relating to the city at night. Submissions of multiple examples from a theme are encouraged.
